The Activities of NSS were broadly divided into two categories – Regular Activities and Special Camping. The activities of NSS during the reporting period are as follows:

REGULAR ACTIVITIES:

SPECIAL CAMPING:

1. Baktawng (Camp I):

A Special camping was held during $5^{th} - 11^{th}$ March, 2019 at Baktawng. The main activity of the camp was construction of waiting-shed. Pamphlets relating to health and sanitation were also distributed. Volunteers with local youths render social service by clearing of weeds at public cemetary on the last day of the camp.
