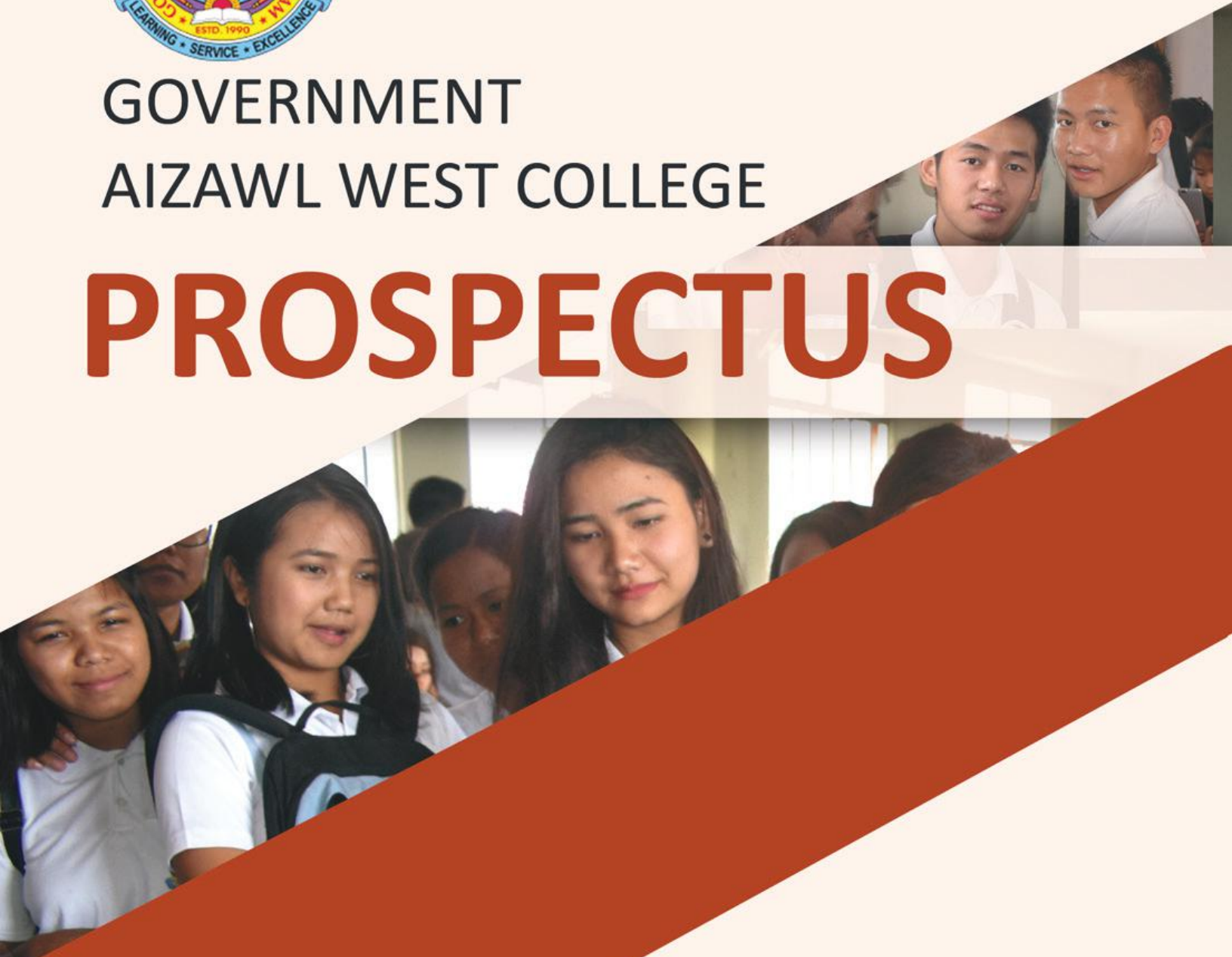

The College

Government Aizawl West College, founded on 2nd May, 1990 was an Evening College that was opened primarily for students who could not attend regular classes in the daytime, especially those who had to support themselves. The permission to open the College was granted by the Government of Mizoram on 14th October, 1990. It was upgraded to a Deficit-grant-in aid status on 1st October, 1995 and thereafter taken over by the Government of Mizoram on 11th October, 2007.

The College was first affiliated to North Eastern Hill University (NEHU) for Pre-University (Arts) on 9th March, 1992 and Degree (Arts) on 9th June, 1994. When the Mizoram University was established by an Act of Parliament on 2nd July, 2001, the affiliation was transferred to the new University. The College was recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) on 23rd June, 2006 under Section 2f and 12B of UGC Act, 1956. The College was the first college in Mizoram to be assessed by National Accreditation and Assessment Council (NAAC), Bangalore on 4th May, 2004. It has been assessed three times by the Council and was awarded B+ grade in its last inspection in June, 2017.

CONDUCT RULES AND REGULATIONS

ATTENDANCE-

Students have to attend at least 75% of regular classes in each subject/paper to sit for End Semester Examinations (ESE) conducted in May and November.

Attendance will be calculated by taking an aggregate of attendance of the students in all their subjects.

A student found absent for more than 15 days at a stretch, without informing the concerned authorities, will be removed from the attendance roll.

Students do not have any leave entitlement.

DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to show respect to their teachers and supporting staff. Undesirable behavior in words or in actions will be viewed seriously.

Students should refrain from taking part in anti-college, anti-government and anti-national activities. Participation in such activities will lead to expulsion from the college.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE

This is a committee formed for the prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment.

GRIEVANCE AND COMPLAINT COMMITTEE

There is a Grievance and Complaint Committee, ready to address the problems faced by students within the college.

PHYSICALLY DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS

Untoward conduct and behavior towards physically disadvantaged students will be seriously dealt with by the authorities. Seat reservation is made for disadvantaged students as per Gov't. Rules.

COLLEGE T SHIRT

The college T-Shirt is to be worn by all students on Wednesday. Department T-shirts may be worn on other days.

RAGGING

Ragging in any form is a punishable offence. If any student is found to be participating in such an activity, stern disciplinary action will be taken.

USE OF INTOXICANTS

Smoking is strictly prohibited in the college. Any student found smoking in the college campus is liable to pay a fine of Rs.200.

The use of alcohol and other intoxicants is strictly prohibited within the college premises and during College functions elsewhere. Any student found indulging in this will have to leave the College.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

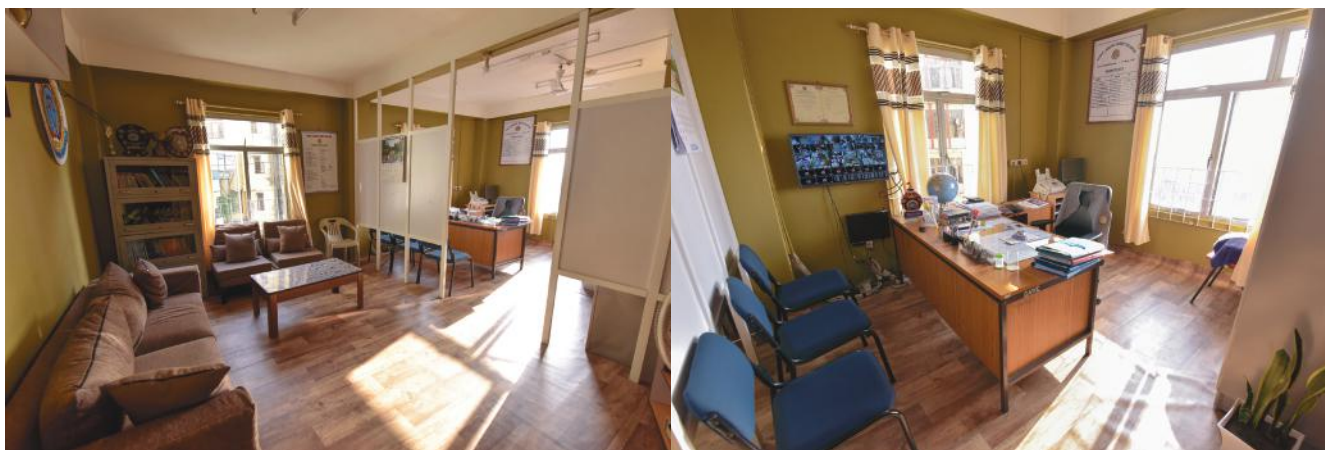
1. Application :

Candidates should apply in the prescribed form available from the college office or download it from the college website within the notified period and face an interview with the following documents:

- a) Attested copy of Certificate and Mark Sheet of last Examination passed.
- b) Two recent passport size photographs
- c) Testimonial and Transfer Certificate from the last institution attended.

2. Eligibility for Admission:

Passed Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate Examination or an equivalent examination conducted by any recognized Board of the State or Central government.

FACILITIES

- 1. Library :** The College runs a Library on the 2nd floor of the Academic Building Complex where computerized reading materials and internet facility are also available. The UGC Net Work Resource Centre is also attached with the library.
- 2. Canteen :** The Staff Welfare Committee of the College runs a canteen where healthy and affordable food items are available for students and staff.
- 3. IGNOU Study Centre :** The College hosts IGNOU STUDY CENTRE which offers a variety of Programmes – Certificate Course, Diplomas, Bachelor Degrees and Master Degrees.
- 4. Centre for Entrepreneurship Development:** The College opened the Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (CED) on March 2016 in collaboration with Mizoram Entrepreneurship Network for the students of GAWC and outsiders.
- 5. Language Laboratory :** The Language Cell of the college runs a language laboratory which helps students in learning English with audio-visual equipments.
- 6. Psychology Laboratory :** The College has a well-established psychology laboratory.
- 7. Remedial Coaching Centre :** Subject to availability of funds, Remedial Classes are provided outside of the regular Routine to improve academic skills and linguistic proficiency of the students in various subjects
- 8. National Institute of Electronics and information Technology (NIELIT):** NIELIT Study Centre has been opened for the students and others. The course is compulsory for all core students.
- 9. Counselling Centre :** To cater the needs of both the College and outside communities the College runs a counselling centre manned by qualified faculty members of the institution.
- 10. Auditorium :** The College has an auditorium at the top floor of the academic building with seating capacity of three hundred approximately.
- 11. Seminar Room :** There is a seminar room equipped with sophisticated communication system with a seating capacity of forty.
- 12. Legal Aid Clinic :** In order to provide accessible legal aids to the students and nearby-communities, the College has a functional clinic in its campus being looked after by a law graduate.
- 13. ICT Enabled Classroom :** All the classrooms in the College are ITC enabled.
- 14. Mini Gym :** To encourage physical fitness and wellness, the college runs a mini gym equipped with modern gym facilities.
- 15. Students' Recreation Room :** The institution has a spacious students' recreation room furnished with facilities like table tennis, chess, etc.

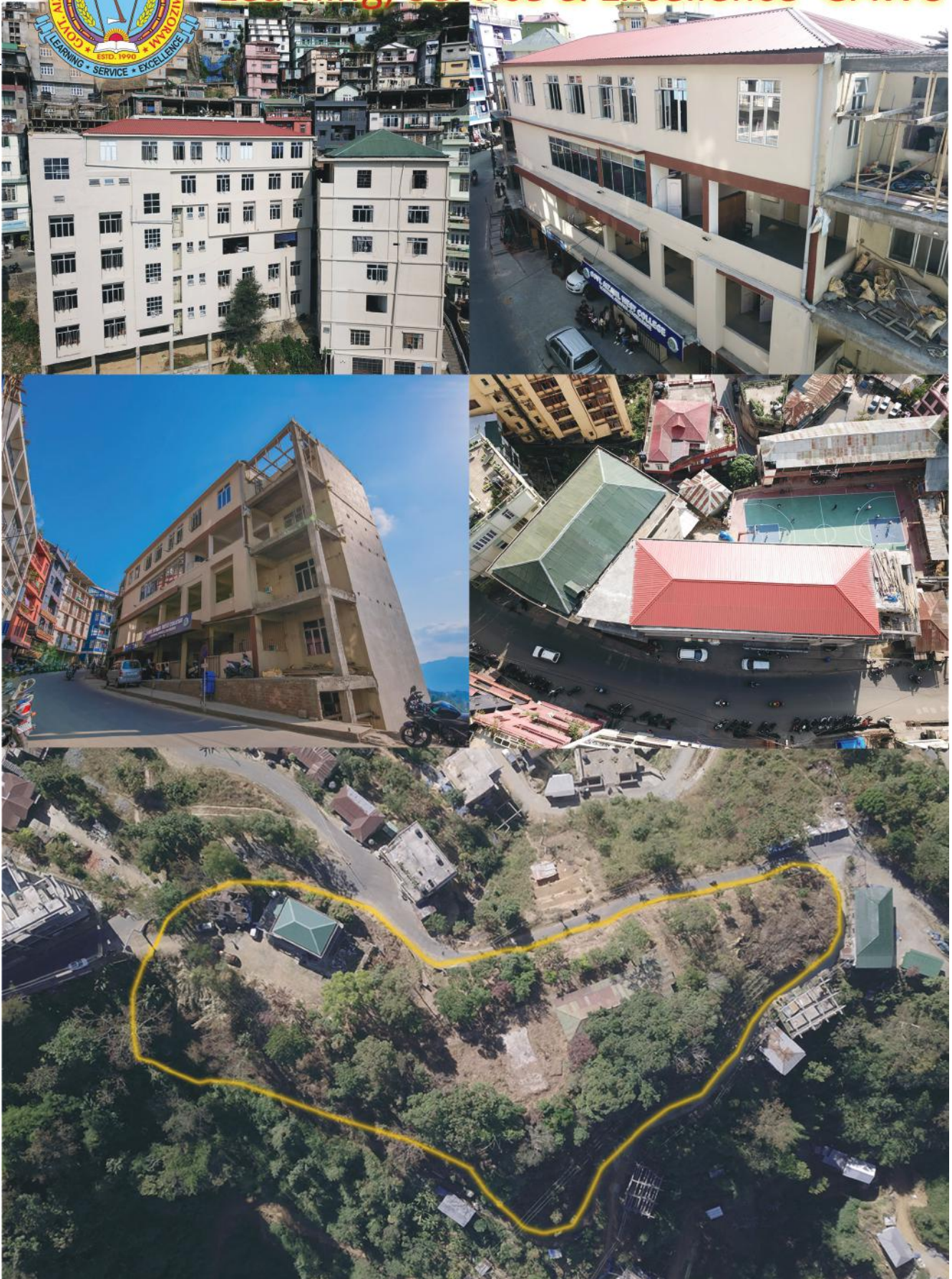

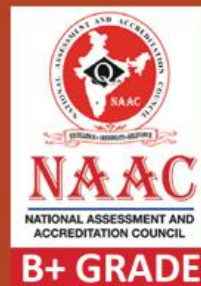
